Dear Mayor and Council,

On behalf of the Building Owners and Managers Association of British Columbia (BOMA), we would like to offer our endorsement for the recent motion put forward by Councillors Lisa Dominato and Sarah Kirby-Yung to direct city staff to create a draft action plan to clear the development permitting and licensing backlog by no later than the end of September 2022.

Permitting delays have been a substantial issue for our members and we have been working with city staff for years on making improvements. While there has been a significant shift to improve the process, timelines, and technology, we still feel there can be more resources put towards implementing solutions.
