Thank you for your May 12, 2021 letter regarding electricity reporting under the *Greenhouse Gas Reduction (Renewable and Low Carbon Fuel Requirements) Act* and the Renewable and Low Carbon Fuel Requirements Regulation (Regulation).

The point of compliance for electricity supply is currently a key area of consideration for amendments to the Regulation. I am aware that the private sector can play a vital role in investing in electric vehicle charging infrastructure, and I understand the substantial costs involved in this undertaking.

The Ministry of Energy, Mines and Low Carbon Innovation is proposing amendments to clarify the point of compliance with respect to electricity in different transportation applications. Accordingly, the Low Carbon Fuels Branch will communicate directly with stakeholders once these amendments have been completed. I appreciate your input suggesting policy improvements to incent the use of low carbon fuels in the Province.
