BC Hydro has installed its first 100-kilowatt electric vehicle charger in Cloverdale to add to its provincial network of more than 100 public fast chargers. The new charger, which can charge a car in 15 to 20 minutes, is one of two charging units installed at the same station. The other unit is 50 kilowatts and can charge a car in 30 to 40 minutes.
