

ELEVATING DEVICES REGULATIONS

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TECHNICAL SAFETY BC

- Issue permits for regulated work
- Issue certifications for regulated industries
- Conduct assessments of work – both physical inspections and via algorithm
- Conduct education and outreach to industry (Tech Talks)
- Communicate about safety issues to the public to raise awareness (for example, carbon monoxide prevention)
- Compliance and enforcement activities



ACT AND REGULATIONS

Technical Safety BC operates within a legislative and regulatory framework that includes the *Safety Standards Act* and Regulations

The *Safety Standards Act* applies to everyone who installs, alters, maintains or operates elevating equipment. All licensed contractors are required to keep up to date with changes in the Act and Regulations.



REGULATORY NOTICES

Safety Orders

Safety orders are regulatory instruments issued by a Technical Safety BC provincial safety manager to prevent or reduce the risk of personal injury or damage to property.

Directives

Directives are regulatory instruments issued by a Technical Safety BC safety officer or safety manager that clarify or provide new interpretation, application or operation of a regulation or code.

Information Bulletins

Information Bulletins provide helpful information and clarification on safety, administrative requirements or other matters that affect a particular technology.

NEW REQUIREMENTS

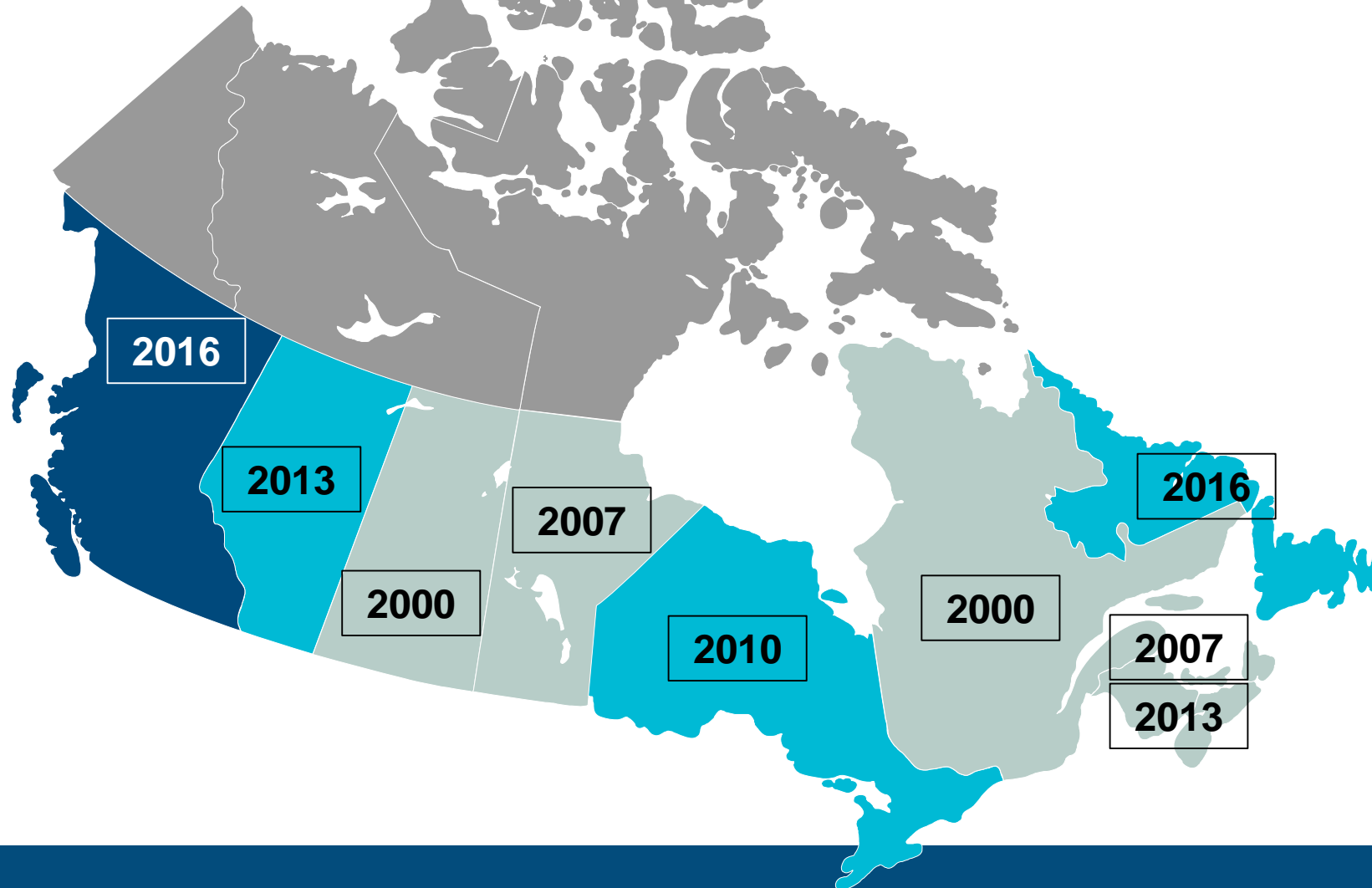


Two key requirements for equipment owners:

Maintenance control programs: MCPs are a customized maintenance schedule for your elevating device that reflects its use and installation. MCPs are now required to ensure each device is properly maintained throughout its life cycle.

New testing requirements: New requirements around annual and five-year testing of elevator systems (Category 1 and Category 5 tests), and for testing of escalators and moving walks (Category 1 tests for escalators and moving walks).
