Working with BOMA Members to Review Your Waste Streams

Urban Impact recommends that a **waste audit** should be completed for each participating BOMA member building. The purpose of the waste audit is to assist BOMA member facilities with measuring the quantity of waste generated and identifying the composition and operational factors for waste generation. Urban Impact partners with Zero Waste Solutions to conduct the waste audit. Deliverables include a **waste audit report** and a **waste reduction waste plan**. Urban Impact reviews the results of the waste audit. The results help them to design customized programs that will suit the individual needs of BOMA's participating members.

In May 2010, Urban Impact was selected to partner with Building Manager's Association of British Columbia (BOMA) to provide a Recycling and Total Waste Solution for its participating members.
